Located at 67 JR Road in Selma, NC, ONSFH offers ten diverse cuisines all under one roof. Opening tenants include FUKU, Barley and Burger, Luna Pizza, Curry in a Hurry, Aroma de Cuba, The Mac House, My Cielo Taqueria, Cock a Doodle Moo, Bean and Bubble, and Butter Cream.

Longleaf Tavern, housed in what was once a humidor in the historic JR Cigars building, will serve as the "heart of the food hall," offering full bar service.
